Last week's the record-breaking A-level and GCSE results achieved by the nation's students propelled our education content to the top of the class, as interest in the category drove engagement to +84% weekly growth; with 4.1m page views the second highest of 2021

A key lockdown trend that continues to grow even after restrictions have lifted across the country is hobbies and interests, as **5.5m page views** last week saw engagement with the category grow +28%. Arts and crafts and DIY, with 2.2m and 1.1m page views respectively, were the top 2 topics

**3.3m**Weekly pets page views

Pets, and our ongoing love affair with them, continue to bring post-lockdown joy to millions of animal lovers nationwide as last week's **3.3m pets pages views** grew +27% week on week; with nearly two thirds of those views related to dogs-related content

Last week's stark 'code red for humanity' warning from the United Nations in its Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change report received universal coverage from Ozone publishers



IPCC report's verdict on climate crimes of humanity: guilty as hell

+35%
Daily UUs growth on 9th August

On Monday 9th August, the day the IPCC report was published, daily science and environment page views grew by +35%, with unique users also up +26%, as the report led the agenda across Ozone publishers

**9.0m**Avg. weekly page views

In the build up to and immediately after June's sustainability focused G7 summit hosted by the UK, 9.0m average weekly science and environment page views was +16% vs. the prior 2-week average

**+24%**Weekly PVs and UUs growth

Weekly engagement with our science and environment content and its overall readership grew by almost a quarter (+24%) when flash flooding hit the UK - including many parts of London - in July
