OZONE OVERVIEW

Last week, the outbreak of another significant international conflict in the Middle East made the world a more dangerous place. Engagement with our **Religion & Spirituality** category increased +54% week on week as Brits sought to understand the divisions between the territories and faiths at the centre of the crisis.

Seasonal interest in the annual Cheltenham Literature Festival boosted engagement with our **Books & Literature** category. Weekly engagement grew +30% to 4.3m page views as arts and culture icons, including Succession actor Brian Cox, comedian and Off Menu podcast host Ed Gamble and author Elizabeth Day, took to the stage to discuss a wide range of topics.

Finally, there was related engagement for three of our top-10 categories – **Business & Finance**, **Video Gaming and Tech & Computing** – after the UK's Competition and Markets Authority finally approved Microsoft's \$69bn takeover of Activision Blizzard. The deal joins the Xbox maker with the creator of the Call of Duty franchise.


The Rugby World Cup continued at the weekend with four, thrilling quarter finals featuring home nations teams Wales, Ireland and England and the rest of the world's best teams.


10.3M Rugby page views last week Last week, the four quarter finals at the Rugby World Cup in France drove engagement with our Rugby content to record levels. More than 10.3m weekly page views increased +31% week on week, with the prior week being a rest week for the remaining teams.

2.9x Higher vs. to the 2023 average Since the week of the tournament's opening match between France and New Zealand on Friday, 8 September, weekly Rugby page views have been 2.8x higher than the 2023 average. Weekly page view are +118% compared to the Six Nations earlier this year.

11% Of all Sport page views are Rugby Across the tournament, more than 10% of all engagement with our **Sport** category has been for **Rugby** content, which is 2.4x higher than we've typically seen this year. Last week, Rugby accounted for 14% of Sport engagement, up +39% week on week.
