Seasonal interest in our **Television** category also continued last week, with seven-day page views up by a quarter. With Strictly and The Great British Bake Off keeping TV viewers entertained, category interest grew significantly at the weekend as the news of Friends actor Matthew Perry's death broke. Daily page views on Sunday were +58% higher compared to the day before, as tribute poured in for the beloved comedian.

Finally, almost 75m **Sport** category page views grew +2% week on week as the Rugby World Cup reached its dramatic conclusion and the mighty Springboks clinched the famous Webb Ellis cup for the fourth time.



9.6M Rugby page views last week

Almost 10m **Rugby** page views last week as the Rugby World Cup concluded was the third highest week for engagement during the tournament. Weekly page views were +7% higher than the championship average and 2.4x greater than the 2023 weekly average.

3x Higher Rugby PVs in semis week The biggest week for engagement was the semi finals. England's defeat to the newly minted world champions South Africa saw weekly page views reach 12.1m – a record high and 3x higher than the 2023 average – as a home nation team in action piqued interest.

+100% Growth in Rugby's share of Sport

This year, **Rugby** page views have accounted for 6% of all **Sport** category engagement. During the Rugby World Cup this share doubled, increasing by +100% to a 12% overall share. This shows how major sporting events can really ramp up engagement.

Rugby World Cup coverage in our publishers




